Discuss your passion for biotechnology, pharmaceuticals or the health care sector at large and your career aspirations. **Be specific** about what aspects of the programme interest you the most and how they **align with your career goals**. Mention specific modules you are looking forward to.
- 5. Research Interests:** If you have a particular research interest or a question you wish to explore during your studies, describe it here. Explain how the programme's research facilities, resources, or expertise can help you pursue these interests.
- 6. Skills and Qualities:** Highlight your personal qualities and skills that make you a good fit for the programme. These might include problem-solving skills, teamwork, resilience, and a genuine curiosity about research in biotechnology, pharmaceuticals or the health care sector at large. Provide examples to illustrate these traits.
